Andrew Spurlock, FASLA, is the President and founding Principal of Spurlock Poirier Landscape Architects. He has 30 years of experience as a landscape architect working with public, private, and institutional clients and with some of the nation's best known architecture firms. His work is noted for sensitivity and innovation, and he approaches each project as an exploration to examine the paradoxes—and possibilities—of site and situation, translating that exploration into compelling solutions.



In the public arena, he has acted as landscape architect for **Petco Park**, the much-heralded new home of Major League Baseball's San Diego Padres which helped ignite new interest in San Diego's Downtown and an unprecedented wave of redevelopment.

Spurlock has also guided a variety of institutional projects including the **J. Paul Getty Center Central Garden** with artist Robert Irwin, a frequent collaborator.

Spurlock has received the Ruocco Award given by Citizens Coordinate for Century 3 for his significant contributions to the profession and the public good of the San Diego area. He was awarded a fellowship for design excellence by the American Society of Landscape Architects in 2002.
